Security & logistic arrangements in place for Independence Day celebrations in Valley: Police

Srinagar, J&K Police on Monday said that all security and logistic arrangements are in place for the upcoming Independence Day celebrations in the Kashmir Valley. Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of the Independence Day rehearsal parade, IGP, Kashmir Zone, V.K.Birdi, stressed that all necessary security and logistical arrangements have been put in place for the upcoming Independence Day celebrations across the Valley.



Rehearsal for the August 15 parade was held in Srinagar on Monday. "Multi-layered security will be in place on August 15 with special focus on sensitive locations to ensure that the event passes off peacefully. All efforts are being made to ensure smooth and incident-free August 15 celebrations in Srinagar and all other districts of the Valley," the IGP said.

Srinagar city and other district headquarters of the Valley remain in sharp focus of the security forces on the country's Republic Day and Independence Day celebrations since armed violence started in J&K in the early 1990s. Terrorists and their overground leaders would call for a boycott of the official events connected with these national-level celebrations. The separatists would also call for a complete shutdown and for observing a 'Black Day' on these events.

After the abrogation of Article 370 when J&K came under direct central control, stone pelting, separatist-called shutdowns, and boycotts of national events have become a thing of the past. Attendance by common citizens and school children has become an essential part of the Independence Day celebrations in Kashmir during the last five years. Locals have been moving around freely on January 26 and August 15 as the people of the Valley have identified themselves with the rest of the country while celebrating these national events.

CM Siddaramaiah's close aide Minister Rajanna to be dropped over voter fraud statement: Sources

Bengaluru, In a major development, the Congress party has decided to seek the resignation of State Minister for Cooperation K.N. Rajanna, a close confidant of Chief Minister Siddaramaiah, over his remarks regarding voter fraud, which allegedly took place during the tenure of the party's government in Karnataka, sources confirmed on Monday.



The party high command has directed Chief Minister Siddaramaiah to obtain Minister Rajanna's resignation on Monday itself.

Minister Rajanna met CM Siddaramaiah at his office in Vidhana Soudha.

Reacting to the news, Rajanna said he would speak after the meeting with the CM. "I am not clinging to power. I will respond by evening," he stated. Leader of Opposition

in the Assembly, R. Ashoka, stated on the floor of the House that Minister Rajanna had tendered his resignation two hours earlier. "I challenge the government on this. If this is not true, let the Speaker suspend me for one year," he declared.

Ashoka further demanded that Minister Rajanna, who was present in the Assembly session, provide clarity on the matter instead of sitting quietly. Minister for Law H.K. Patil and Minister for Revenue Krishna Byre Gowda maintained that sudden media reports should not be taken up for discussion in the House.

Congress leaders had earlier submitted a complaint to Karnataka in-charge Randeep Singh Surjewala over Minister Rajanna's statements against the party regarding election fraud.

When asked about the statement of Minister K.N. Rajanna, who stated that the party should have taken note of the alleged election fraud much earlier than raising it now, Deputy CM D.K. Shivakumar stated that Minister Rajanna has issued a totally wrong statement. "He doesn't know. My Chief Minister will reply to it, and the high command will look into the matter," Shivakumar said.

Earlier, on August 8, Rajanna had stated, "Rahul Gandhi has made statements backed by documents. He is speaking with authority, and we must endorse his statements -- there is no doubt about it. The BJP is well aware of the malpractices. The RSS, the frontal organisation of the BJP, is manipulating everything."

Both claimed to be the original Akali Dal that came into being on December 14, 1920, to free gurdwaras from the control of 'mahants'. The election of the party was conducted following last year's edict by the supreme temporal seat of the Sikhs that tasked the five-member committee to hold a membership drive for the party and subsequently hold the organisational elections.

Nearly half of all senior citizens are experiencing abuse and 'mistreatment' in public spaces. According to the survey, the senior citizens faces abuse in the areas like the actual experience of elders as they interacted with people and service providers; elder perceptions on elder ill-treatment; the general state of mind of elders as they stepped out of their homes; and a wish-list of their expectations from society. 55% believed that Indian society discriminates against elders.

money for meeting what schools demands for extracurricular activities. It is a common sight in city buses, the seats "supposed to be" reserved for senior citizens are invariably occupied by others. To steal from elders money from their bank account is the simplest thing by own children/in-laws/bank staff/hackers. Don't we feel shame of ourselves treating our elders like that which is so disgraceful? Generally, we forget that one day, in ageing, we will also face such thing. It's India, where we learn to respect our elders. But, today, new generation has forgotten all things.

The world is undergoing significant demographic changes. Estimates indicate that by 2050, the global population of people above the age of 60 will exceed the number of younger people. According to UN estimates, the global population of people aged 60 years and older is set to touch about 1.2 billion in 2025 and globally around 4 per cent to 6 per cent of elderly people have experienced some form of maltreatment at home.

Today, elders are abused in public/private places - the resultant of living conditions. Under the present scenario each and everything is being measured by Money Power. The problems of the elderly are primarily economic, marked by the loss of independent incomes. Health-related problems typically dog them too. Lack of safety and security are added perils, especially in urban settings. It was found that 65 per cent of elderly people are poor with no source of known income. 35 per cent have money or properties, savings, investments, inheritance and or supportive children. Irrespective to their financial status most of them face abuse in one form or the other.

Government must create awareness about the rights of elderly people, advocacy of old age issues at all level of governance and ensure implementation of policies pertaining to protection of interests of senior citizens. Senior citizens who are unable to maintain themselves financially shall have the right to apply to a maintenance tribunal for an allowance from their children and relatives. We need to give more stress to take concrete action and develop specific measures to address and monitor financial exploitation and material abuse in the context of an ageing society. The right of an elderly citizen to live a life of dignity must be made justifiable. Programmes to enhance skills and knowledge in geriatric care are needed.
